

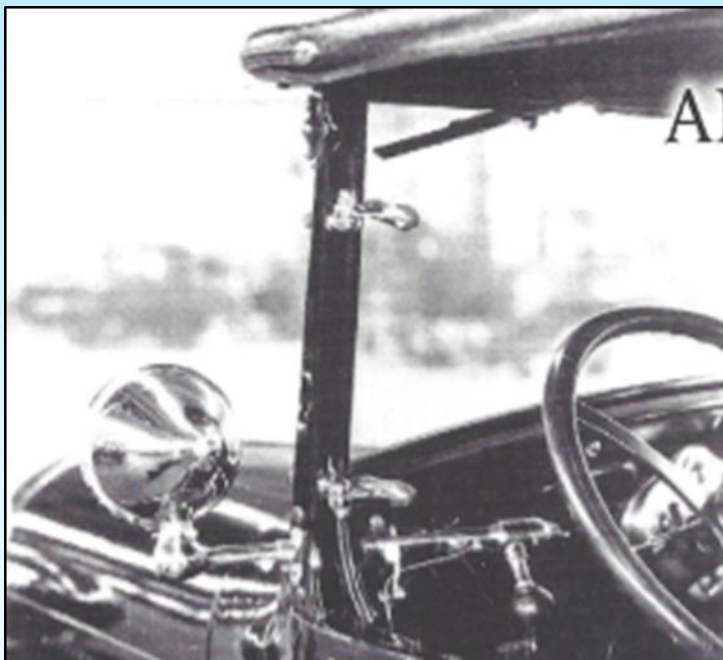

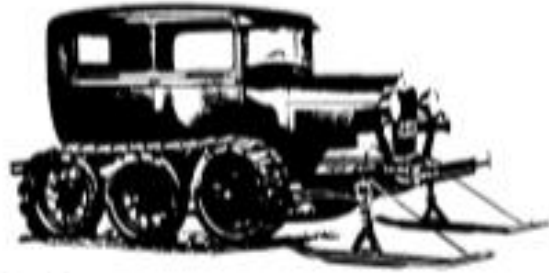
AREA 16 – ACCESSORIES

DOES NOT INCLUDE: Normal variations of production models (such as fender step plates, or welled fenders) or safety items.

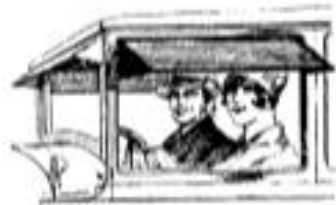
REQUIRED FOR JUDGING: Model A's with no accessories are to be awarded full points.

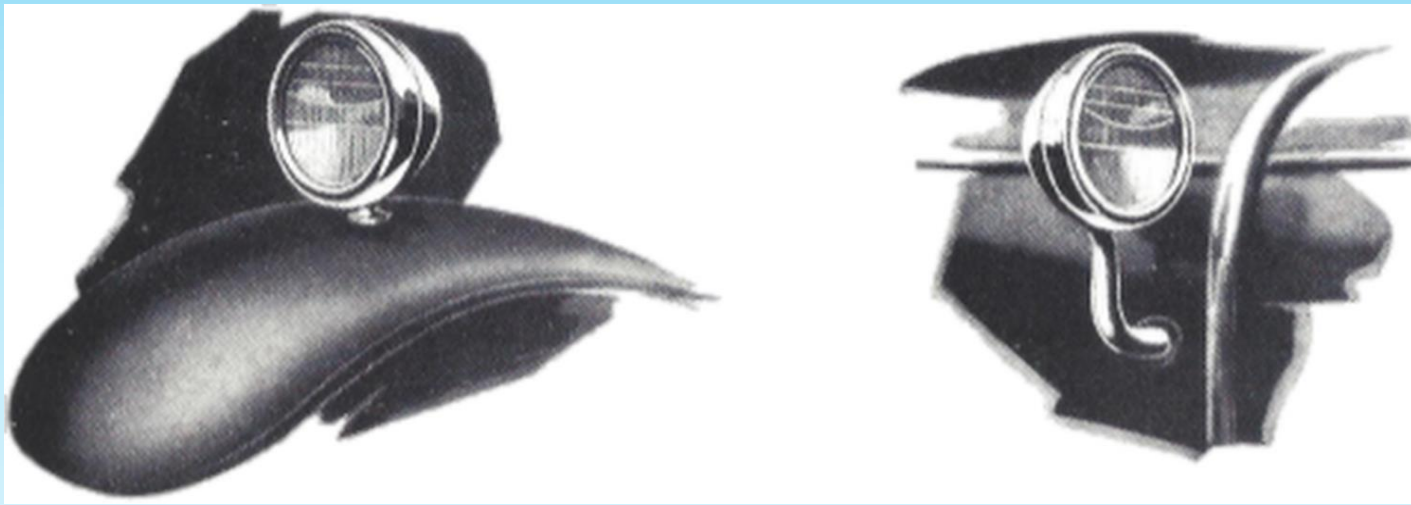

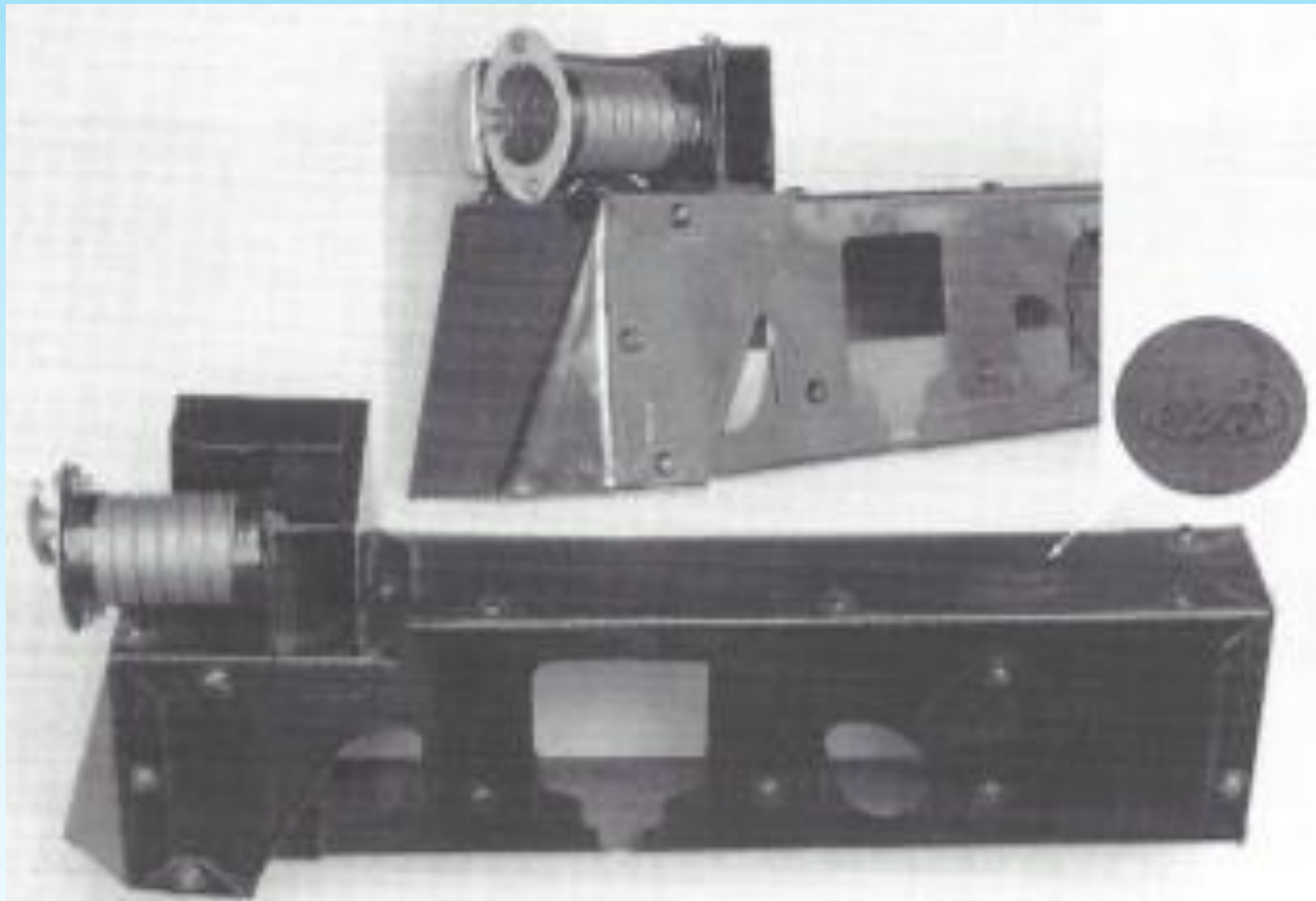

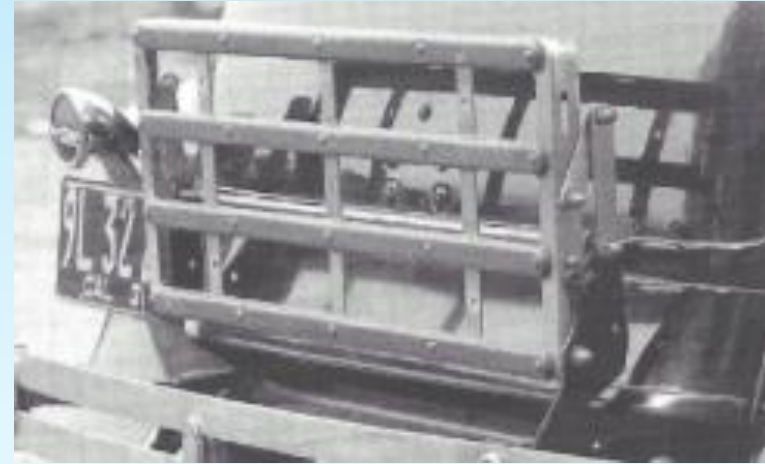

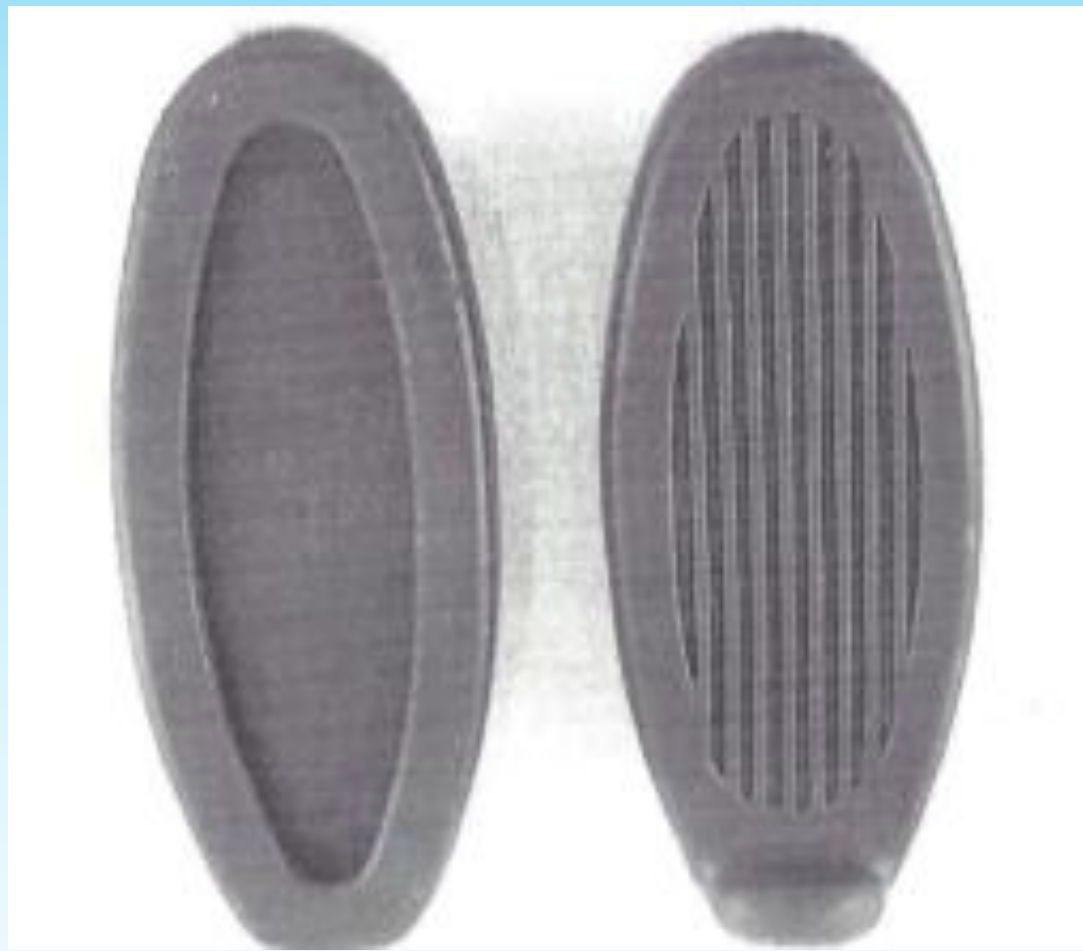

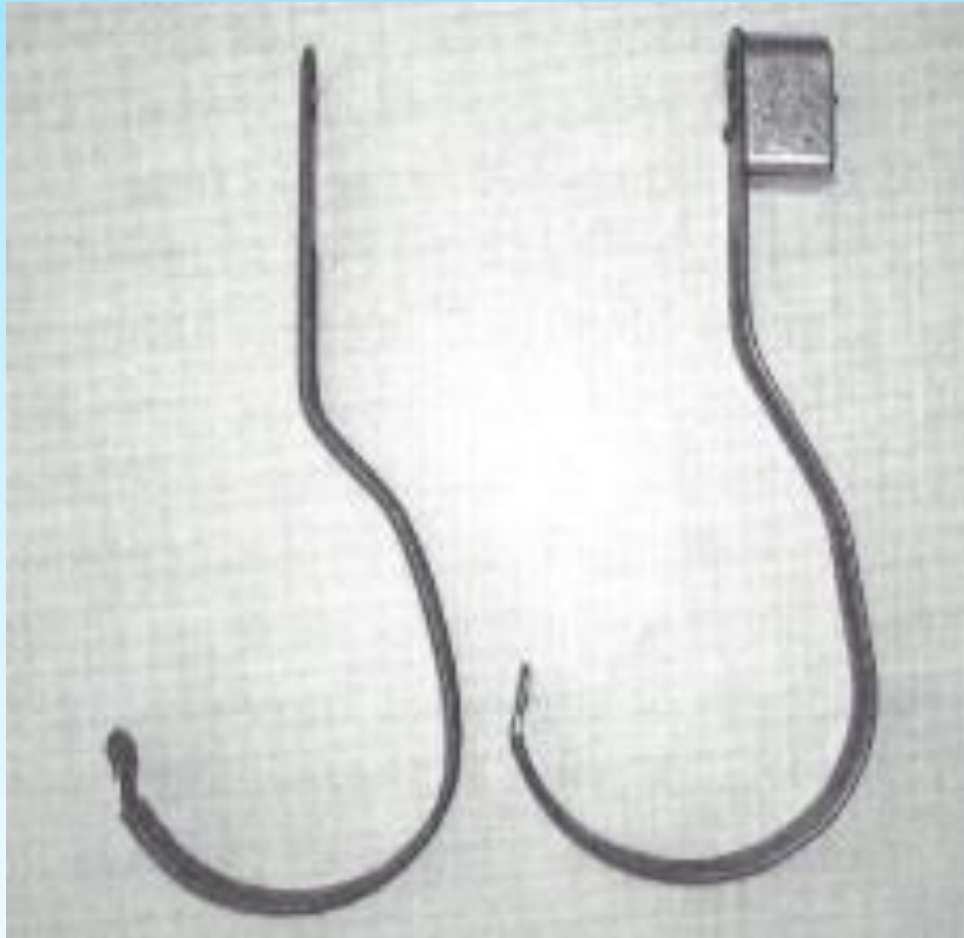

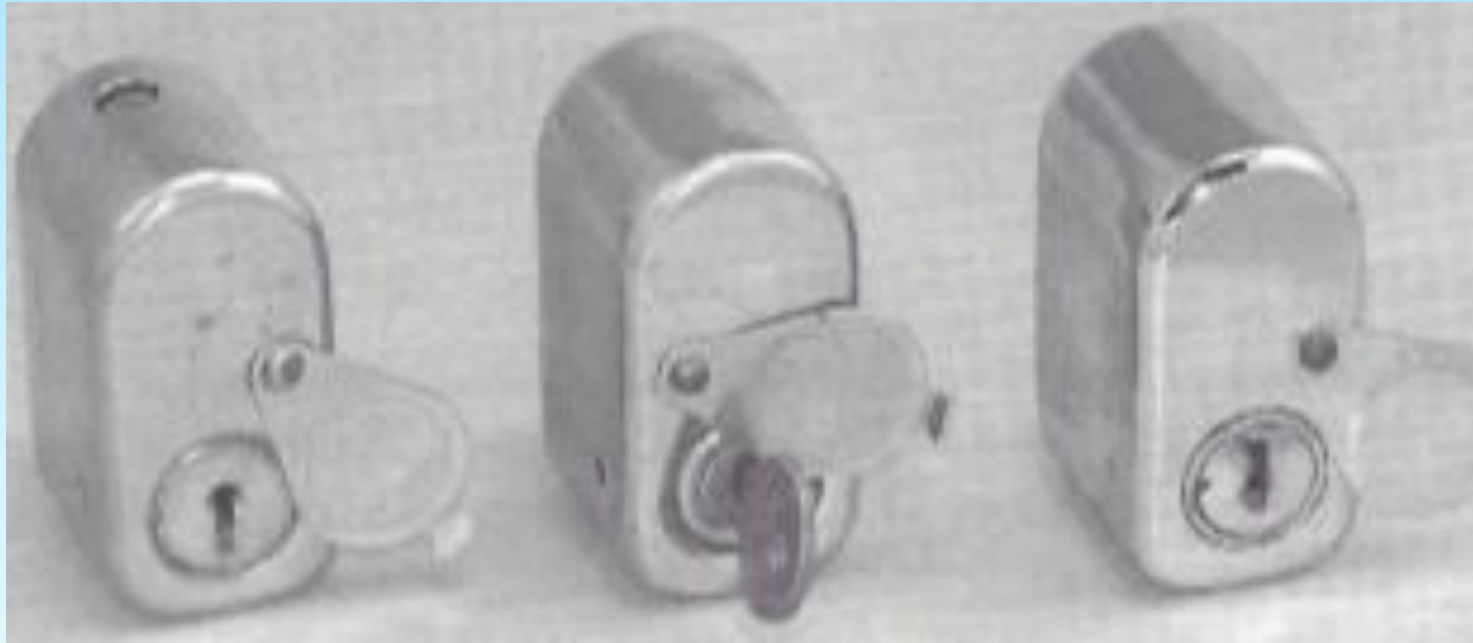

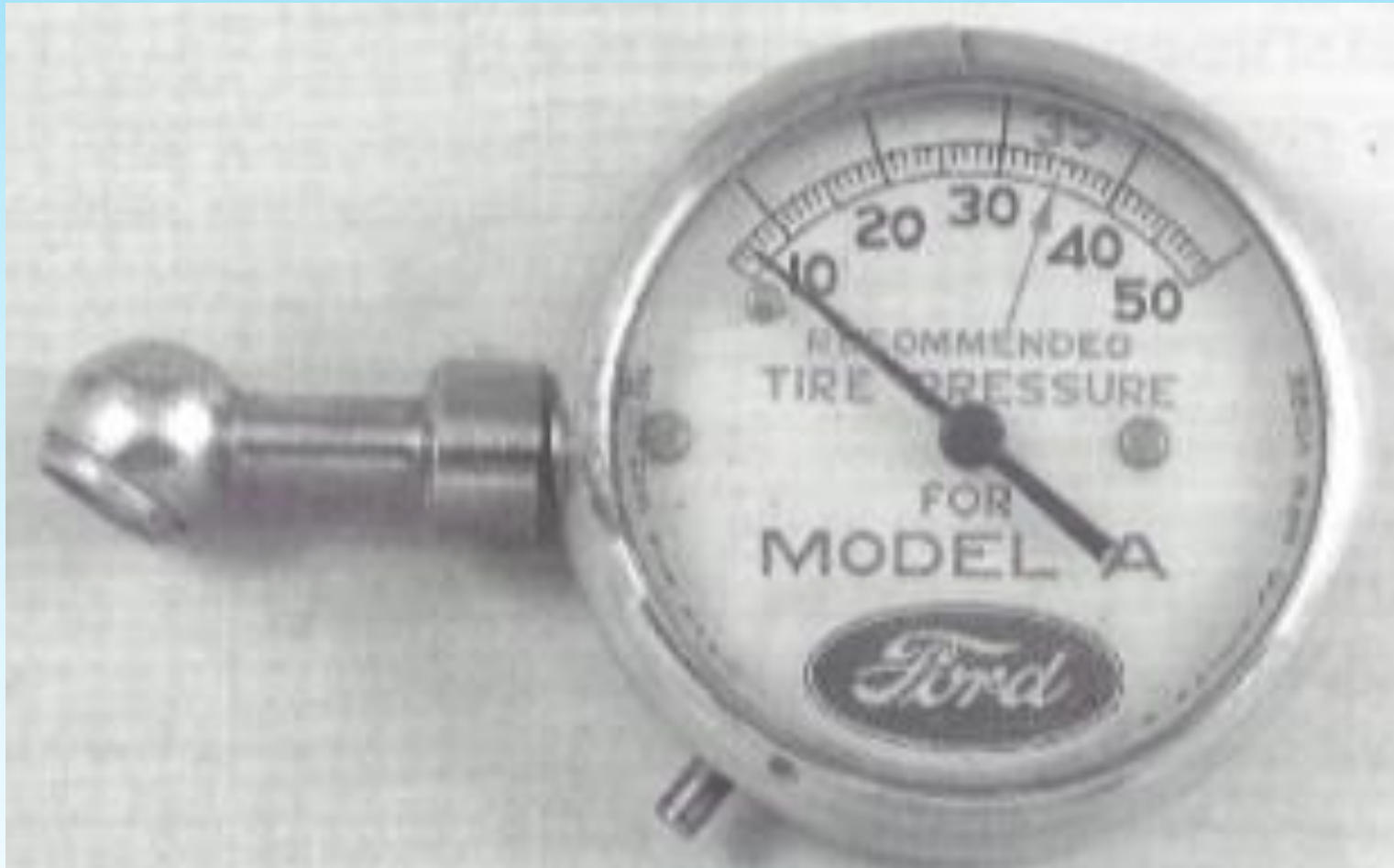

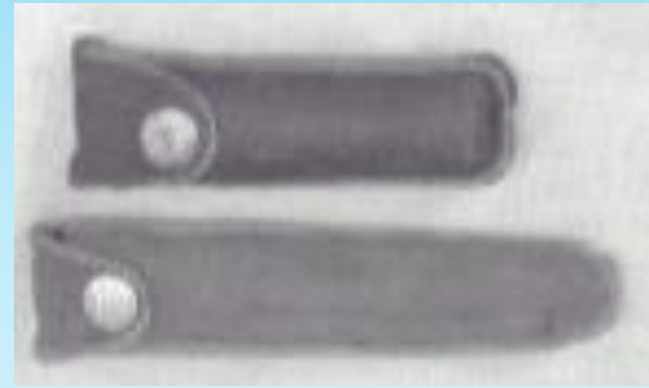

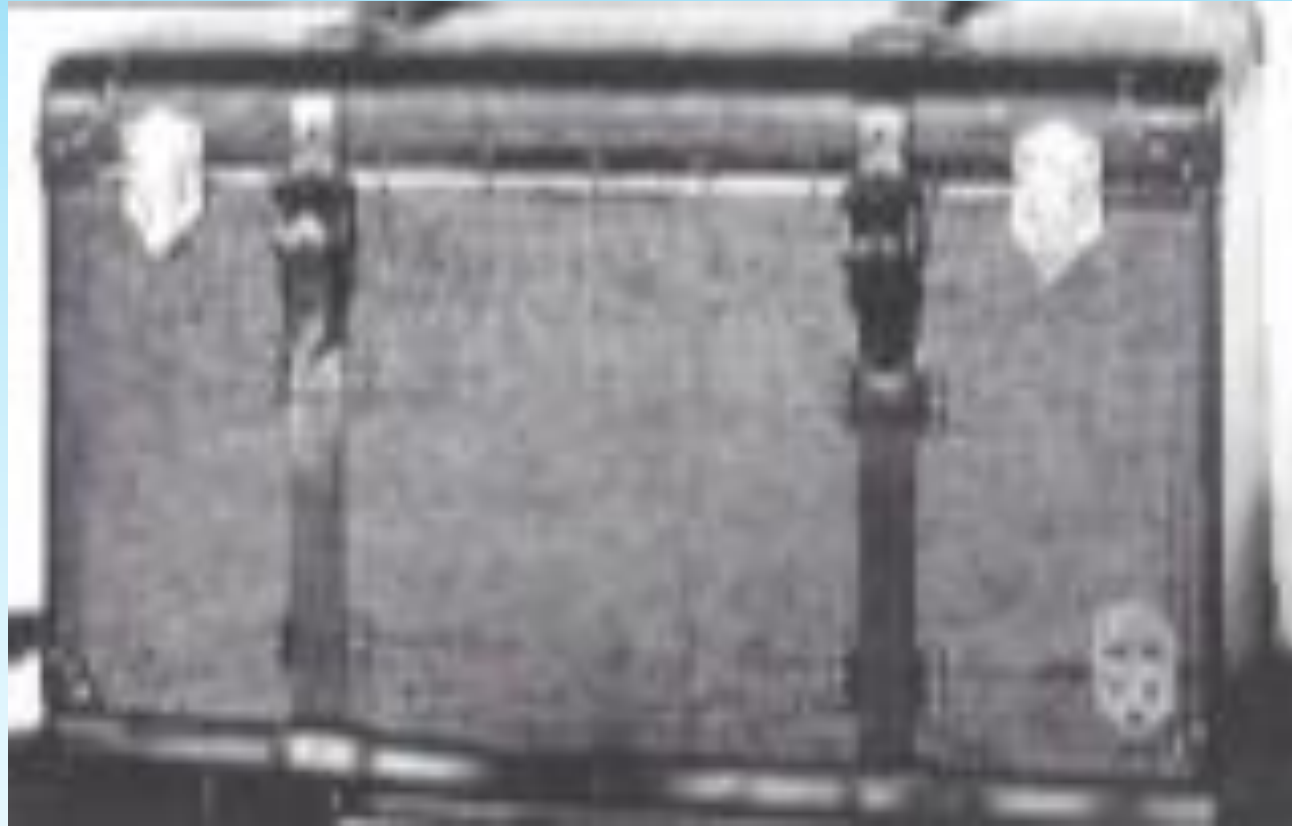

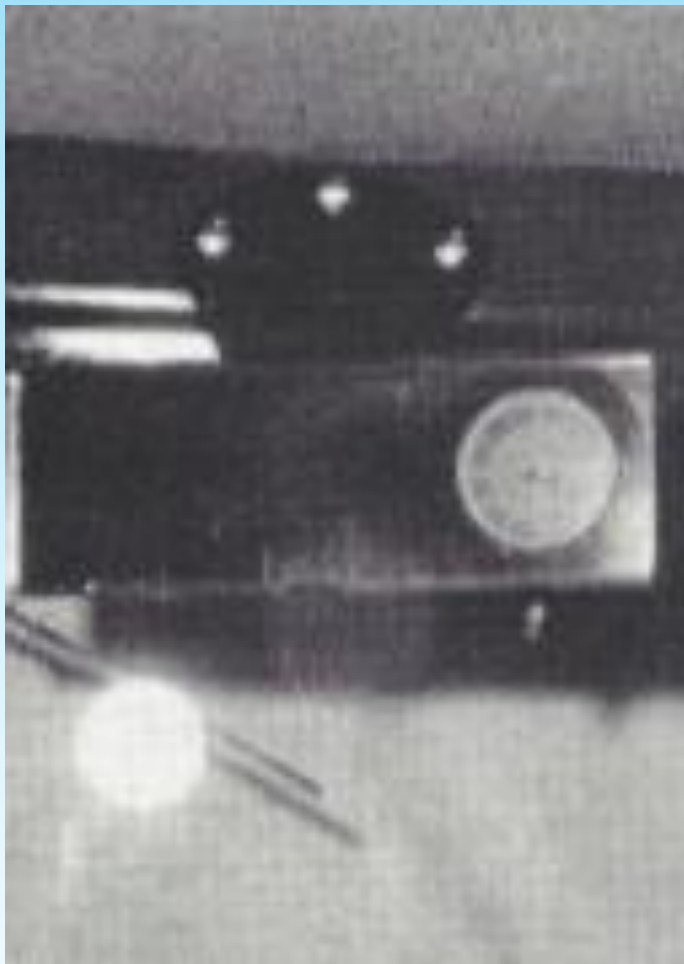
